






TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS (TA = +25°C, unless otherwise specified)






COLLECTOR CURRENT vs. BASE TO EMITTER VOLTAGE




DC CURRENT GAIN vs. **COLLECTOR CURRENT**

Base to Emitter Voltage VBE (V)




vs. COLLECTOR TO BASE VOLTAGE


REVERSE TRANSFER CAPACITANCE



COLLECTOR CURRENT vs. COLLECTOR TO EMITTER VOLTAGE




GAIN BANDWIDTH PRODUCT vs. COLLECTOR CURRENT






MAXIMUM AVAILABLE GAIN/INSERTION POWER GAIN vs. FREQUENCY


